HISTORY

- ❖ The property was built in the XVIIth century, and Jean Jacques Lesgourgues took over it in 1999.
- ❖ « *Peyros* » means a stony place in Gascony language, which is representative of the terroir
- ❖ The 20 hectare vineyard got the Terra Vitis and HVE certification in 2018

VINEYARD

- ❖ Plot selection parcellaire of 2ha facing south and southeast
- ❖ Terroir : rolled pebbles and intermediate Graves on a clay-silty soil.
- ❖ Average age of vines: 20 years old
- ❖ Yield: 40hl/ha

GRAPE VARIETY

- ❖ 100% Tannat

VINIFICATION

- ❖ Maceration under grape marc of three weeks
- ❖ Smooth vinification in small stainless steel vats.

AGEING POTENTIAL

Until from 8 to 10 years

TASTING NOTES

- ❖ The nose is intense with subtle black fruits and spicy notes with green pepper.
 - ❖ On the palate, this wine is very round and supple with an unctuous attack. Then it is open with a subtle freshness with red fruits aromas.
- Soft and silky tannins with a long finish revealing character of the wine

GOURMET INSTANT

- ❖ A fully-expressive wine to pair with planks and dishes, to share with friends.
