HISTORY

Montesquieu, first winemaker of Graves area at « La Brede » was the first to promote this appellation which is the oldest one in Bordeaux. Vignobles Lesgourgues acquired this Graves historical cru in 1997.

VINYARD

- ❖ Located in the northern part of the appellation nearby the village of Saint Selve.
- ❖ 37 acres of white over the 61 acres of the property.
- ❖ Average age: 15 years
- ❖ Siliceous graves and clay graves on a calcareous ground
- ❖ Production : 12 000 bottles

GRAPE VARIETALS

- ❖ 60% Semillon
- ❖ 40% Sauvignon Blanc

VINIFICATION

- ❖ Pre-fermented maceration
- ❖ Cold racking of the must
- ❖ Aged in french oak barrel for 6 months

AGEING POTENTIAL

1 to 3 years



TASTING NOTES

Pale yellow robe with green reflects.

A powerful and complex nose of white fruits (quince, peach, pear) with notes of exotic fruits and acacia flower.

A refreshing and crispy palate, well rounded by the aged Semillon with a toasty finish.
